What is AITE?

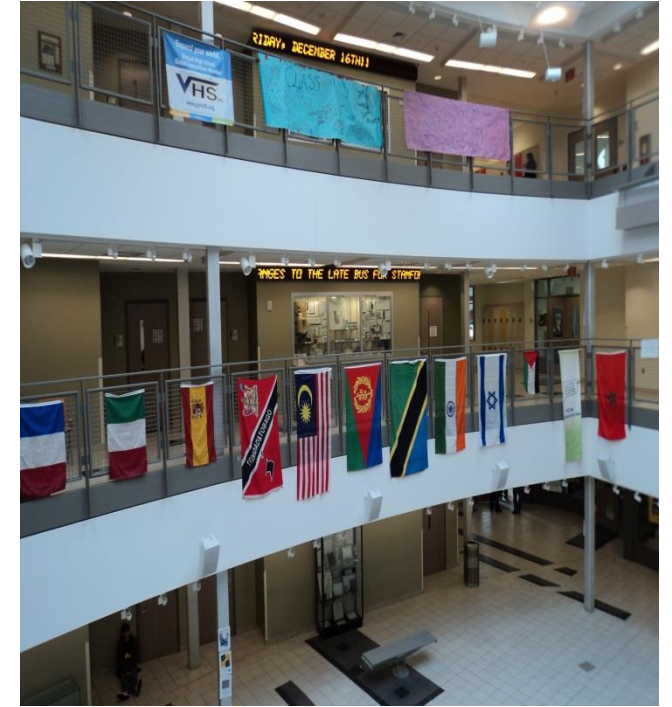
- an award winning inter-district magnet high school located in Stamford

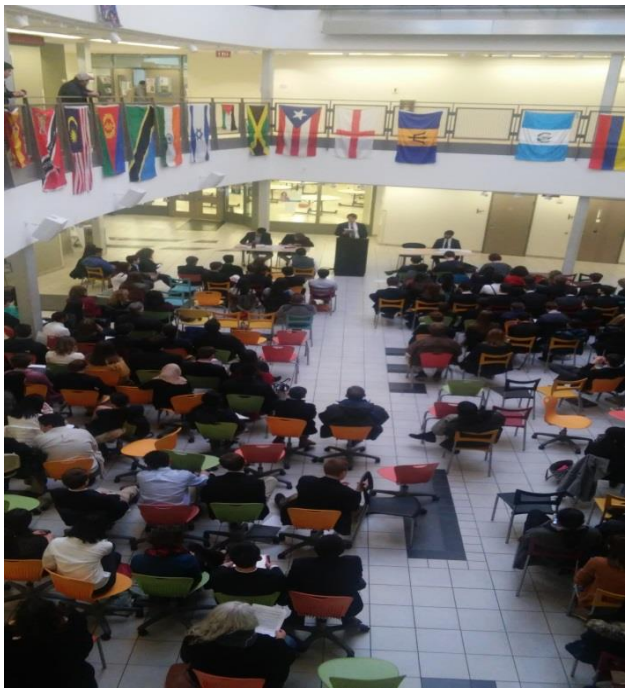
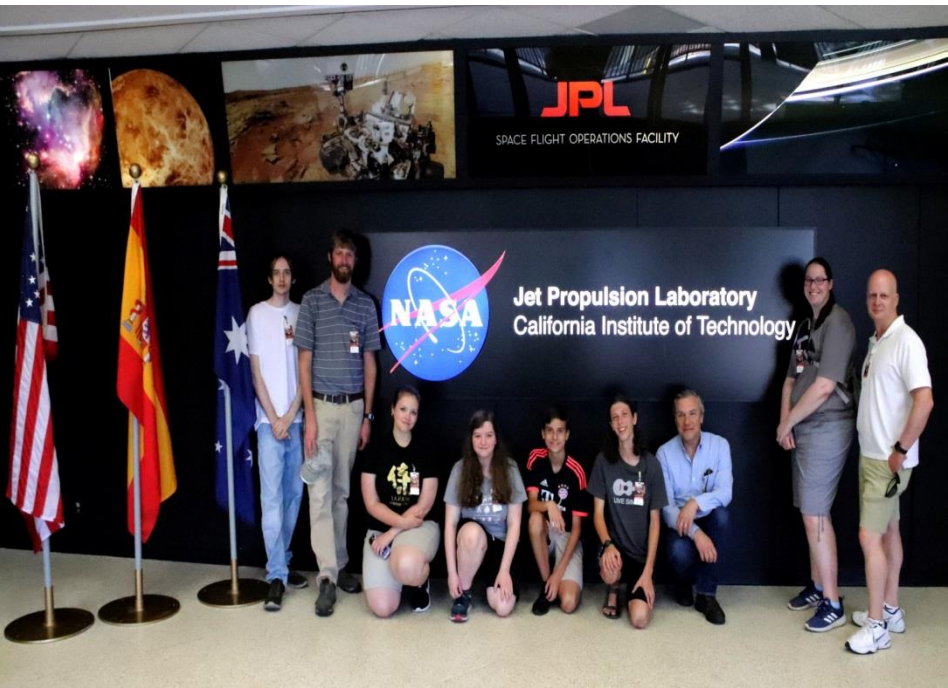

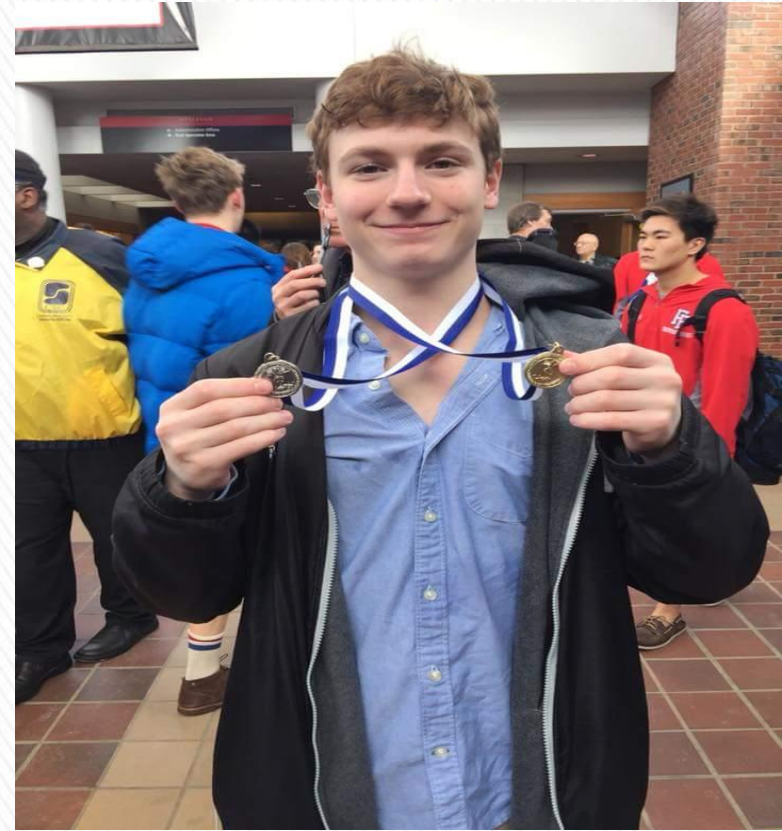
